You navigate the keyboard and crossovers with graceful ease. The half note melody emerges vividly. In m. 15, experiment with a new color for the minor shift as the fish move to murkier waters. I enjoyed your peaceful ending.

The command of this two-part dialogue is confident. You are listening to the hands with equal interest. Your tempo is lively and maintains forward momentum. Exaggerate the dramatic growth into the climax in m. 16. Another engaging presentation--good work!
